




Do you know about the English learner EL program at your child's school?






In your opinion has your child's/children's use of English improved over the past school year?






Do you know how a student exits the English learner program?




To exit the English Learner program students must show English proficiency by meeting the following criteria:



- A passing grade of "C" or "2" in any ELA related course on the most recent school report card.
- The student's parent/s must be notified and agree to the placement.



• Earning the required score on a grade-level state or district English Language Arts (ELA) assessments. This may include the state Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBAC), district I-Ready ELA assessment, or a unit assessment from the current ELD curriculum. The score needed depends on the assessment.
